Treatment on furniture

TANTE POLLY has to be chosen in function of the furniture and its colour: either a natural colour for colourless or light coloured furniture or an antique colour for darker furniture.

*Applying TANTE POLLY

The polishing wax can be applied with a brush or a cloth. The wood needs some time to absorb the wax. The longer the wax gets absorbed, the deeper the gloss will be. An ideal drying time is 24 hours.

*Polishing TANTE POLLY

To polish waxed furniture, we recommend starting off with a brush with natural bristles. Afterwards one can advance to polishing with a soft cotton cloth.

*Maintenance

Polishing with a cotton cloth in the course of the year suffices to maintain the gloss. After a while the full treatment has to be redone.

Treatment on parquet

*Applying TANTE POLLY

The wax needs to be applied preferably on a previously nitrocellulose lacquer (e.g. SBX SEALER NC-20300) treated parquet floor.

*Polishing TANTE POLLY

Preferably mechanically.
